## Newton Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session March 3, 2010

Board Members in Attendance: John Pardue, Ronald Koldjeski and Douglas Pallman

Board Guests in Attendance: Francine Miller, Secretary/Treasurer; Scot Haan, CEO

Meeting Called to Order at 7:37PM with Pledge of Allegiance.

**Announcement:** There will be a hearing on Monday, March 8, 2010 at 7PM regarding the proposed amendment to the cell tower ordinance.

### **New Business:**

***Resolution:*** Motion by Pardue to pass and sign the adoption of the Lackawanna/Luzerne County Bi-County Hazard Mitigation Plan, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Koldjeski. Motion voted, all in favor.

***JP Mascaro Bill:*** A bill from Mascaro was received for a dumpster placed at a residence on Summit Lake Road. Haan will seek the payment from the resident and if not paid the Township will look into the matter. Haan was instructed NOT to pay himself.

***H&K Piggyback Bid:*** DPW to look at the allowance amounts for material to see if those quantities will work for us – tabled until Monday night.

Bills and payroll were signed and discussed.

### **Unfinished:**

Pardue discussed his meeting with DEP and PADOT regarding the clean up at River Road. Newton Township owns 1 ½ miles that need to be cleaned. DEP is trying to get more money for us. Ransom Township cleaned up 300 tires in a ½ mile of road. PADOT will help with the cost of tire removal and are also in the process of closing the road.

Koldjeski stated that he would like to discuss with Sileo the prospect of seeking reimbursement for deductibles on claims if the Township wins the case.

Being no further discussion, meeting adjourned. **Motion by Pardue to adjourn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pallman. Motion voted, all in favor.**
