Newton Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session May 5, 2010

Board Members in Attendance: John Pardue, Ronald Koldjeski and Douglas Pallman

Board Guests in Attendance: Francine Miller, Secretary/Treasurer; Scot Haan, CEO

Meeting Called to Order at 7:38PM with Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business:

Skatepark: Greg Pascale and Lee Jamison were present to discuss the fact that the Township negated the lease. Pascale and Jamison stated that they would still like to get the project done. They still need steel, rebar, concrete and fencing. Pascale was tied up in other issues and was unable to proceed with the project until now. He believes that the skatepark could be finished by the fall of 2010 with the Township's assistance. Jamison suggested advertising that anyone interested in seeing this project completed to show up at a specific day and time. Pardue stated that they need the money not advertising. Pascale stated that they need commitments for the labor and would like Township's assistance with money and believes this would be a benefit to the public. Pardue stated that speaking for himself; he wants to see that the skatepark has the people to help to complete the project and the donations. Pascale stated that he will be back next month with a time table and business plan. This project was started six years ago. Pascale stated that he already has a commitment from Fiegleman's for the rebar and they will also give a \$500 credit to them. They also have a commitment from Scranton Craftsman for the concrete at cost and the skatepark will be able to pay in installments.

Municipal Building: Tabling the roof bids until further investigation is done.

June Meetings: The Work Session normally to be held on Wednesday, June 9, 2010 will be postponed until Monday, June 14, 2010 at 7PM with the General Meeting at 7:30PM.

Bills were signed and discussed.

Being no further discussion, meeting adjourned. **Motion by Koldjeski to adjourn, 2nd by Pardue. Motion voted, all in favor.**
