Newton Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session August 4, 2010

Board Members in Attendance: John Pardue, Ronald Koldjeski and Douglas Pallman

Board Guests in Attendance: Scot Haan, Code Enforcement Officer; Francine Miller, Secretary/Treasurer

Meeting Called to Order at 7:35PM with Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business:

Daydreamers: Amber and Kim Tenio came to the meeting to discuss that there is an empty locker room at the recreation center that has a water problem. The daycare contacted B-Dry for a quote to fix the problem and was given a quote of \$6068.00. The daycare would like to use this space to place ten 3-year-olds at no cost to the daycare in place of paying for the B-Dry. They did not discuss this proposal with the Recreation Committee until they found out from the Board if it could be done. The Supervisors stated that the daycare needs to discuss this with the Committee first and with recommendation from the Committee, the Board would discuss an amendment with the lease with our solicitor.

Rick Holt: Rick Holt of Upper Maple Drive came to the Board to discuss an issue with the intersection of Upper Maple Drive and Newton Ransom Blvd. He believes that this area is a safety issue due to the steep incline of the road and asked that since the Board is working on getting a section of the road patched, they could get someone to look into changing the road. The Board will check into what it would take to make the incline less steep.

Recreation Committee: Cathy Hardaway came to the Board to discuss the boiler replacement. Hardaway stated that the Committee is concerned with getting the project completed before the cold season. Pardue stated that we can check with PSATS to see if the Township can advertise for bids with very limited criteria such as building size and number of zones and receive bids based on the bidders design and not common set of specs. Hardaway also discussed that the Committee will be hiring Michele Breslin to work on a grant application for doing the gym floor and windows. Discussion also ensued regarding the hiring of a general manager to oversee the everyday working of the center.

Bills were signed and discussed.

Being no further discussion, meeting adjourned. **Motion by Koldjeski to adjourn, 2nd by Pallman. Motion voted, all in favor.**
