New Business:

Bob DeSandis: Mr. DeSandis, Certified Water Operator, came to the meeting to discuss the water testing procedures for the Recreation Center. He stated that the populations of the daycare and preschool determine the tests that are required by law to be done. The Recreation Center is non-chlorinated water and a non-transient community, meaning we do not sell the water. Len Shebby, DEP, is our contact for the water testing. DeSandis stated that Calabro does the quarterly bactise for total chloroform. Benchmark and Quantum are doing the majority of the testing. DeSandis stated that he is paid to draw the water samples, store the water, uses the correct bottles and delivers the samples to the test labs in a timely fashion. DeSandis is to get the information to the Township as to what tests need to be done and when so that we can get other pricing from other labs.

Bills were signed and discussed. **Motion by Koldjeski to pay the township bills as read, 2nd by Pallman. Motion voted, all in favor. Motion by Koldjeski to pay the Recreation Center bills as approved, 2nd by Pallman. Motion voted, all in favor.**

Scot Haan, CEO, stated that at the meeting between the gas committee, the planning commission and Jack Varaly, they discussed incorporating changes to residential districts and incorporate into the comprehensive plan.

Being no further discussion, meeting adjourned. **Motion by Koldjeski to adjourn, 2nd by Pallman. Motion voted, all in favor.**
